

Introduction

The notes under this heading come out of the experience of ministering many times over many years to individuals who have desired to walk in closer relationship with God but who have found themselves held back by issues countering that desire. There are various reasons for such issues arising. Often, for example, it can come down to there being some area in the life of an individual not being properly submitted to the lordship of Jesus.

A scriptural basis for such ministry has been included and, over time, it is hoped to add to the notes to embrace a greater number of topics.

Almost invariably, persons receiving ministry will be members of a church and these notes are provided on the basis that those who use them will do so with the permission of, and under the direction of, church leadership who take full responsibility for the ministry. In that way there is accountability, the church leadership can oversee the ministry, the leadership will know what is going on in their church and the leadership will also know who is involved.

These notes should be regarded as a guide only to ways of approaching ministry. Qualified medical, psychiatric or legal advice may need to be sought in certain situations and nothing in the notes must be taken as a substitute for such advice. Moreover, the way in which the notes are used is beyond the control of the writer and Mannawords.
